**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision reducing the FY 2018-19 Long Bill appropriations for the Department of Public Safety by a total of \$177,707 cash funds from fees paid for concealed carry permit applications. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require a reduction of 2.0 FTE.
