101	CONCERNING LIMITING THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE WHO MAY SELL
102	VEHICLES TO DEALERS UNDER A WHOLESALER'S LICENSE ISSUED
103	BY THE MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER BOARD.

Bill Summary

Current law requires a wholesaler's license to sell motor vehicles or powersports vehicles to dealers. The bill limits the number of individuals who may act as a wholesaler under a license to 2.
