

Affirm Natural Gender, 2025-2026

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Legislative Declaration.

We the people of Colorado find and declare that failure to affirm a child's natural gender according to their biological sex is detrimental to the child's mental and emotional health.

SECTION 2. In the Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** section 67.5 to title 27 as follows:

27.67.5 Affirm Natural Gender.

Adult persons caring for or providing services to children aged 0-18 years old must affirm the child's natural gender in all aspects of care and services according to the biological sex of the child as designated on the child's original birth certificate.

27.67.6 Enforcement.

Failure to affirm a child's natural gender in any aspect of care or service may result in fines and loss of privileges such as permits and licenses to provide care or services for children.

SECTION 3. Self-Executing.

This provision shall be self-executing and shall supersede any conflicting state statutes, legislation, or judgments. This provision shall take effect and applies beginning December 25, 2026, if approved by the vote of the people.

SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** HB 25-1309 and 25-1312.
