SENATE BILL 25-250

BY SENATOR(S) Amabile and Kirkmeyer, Bridges;  
also REPRESENTATIVE(S) Bird and Taggart, Sirota, Gonzalez R.

CONCERNING REPEALING THE DISORDERED EATING PREVENTION PROGRAM,  
AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, REDUCING AN APPROPRIATION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** part 21 of article 20.5 of title 25.


**SECTION 2. Appropriation - adjustments to 2025 long bill.** To implement this act, the general fund appropriation made in the annual general appropriation act for the 2025-26 state fiscal year to the department of public health and environment for use by the prevention services division for the disordered eating program is decreased by \$91,398, and the related FTE is decreased by 1.0 FTE.

**SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for


