

**Initiative Title: Clarification of Crime, and restriction on use of Emergency Lights.**

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

**SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes Title 18-1, AMEND section 104 (1)**

(1) The terms "offense" ~~and "crime" are synonymous and~~ means a violation of, or conduct defined by, any state statute for which a fine or imprisonment may be imposed. THE TERM "CRIME" IS AN OFFENSE ONLY WHEN THERE IS A VICTIM, PROPERTY DAMAGE, OR HARM.

**SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes Title 42-4, AMEND section 238 (2)(a)&(b)**


(2)(a) A peace officer described in section 16-2.5-101, C.R.S WHO IS RESPONDING TO AN EMERGENCY AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 42-4-239; or


(b) WHILE RESPONDING TO AN EMERGENCY AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 42-4-239 AND In actual physical control of a vehicle expressly authorized by a chief of police or sheriff to contain a lamp or device that is designed to display, or that is capable of displaying if affixed or attached to the vehicle, a red or blue light visible from directly in front of the center of the vehicle; or..

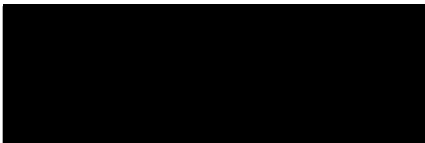

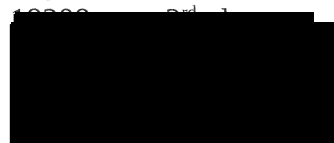
