Summary Information

Overview. The bill extends the reporting deadline on the Statewide Longitudinal Data System by the Office of Information Technology.

No fiscal impact. The bill has no fiscal impact on state or local governments.

Summary of Legislation

[House Bill 24-1364](#) created the Statewide Longitudinal Data System (SLDS) in the Office of Information Technology (OIT) and required the office to annually report on education and workforce outcomes from the data system beginning April 15, 2026. The bill moves the deadline of the first report to September 15, 2026.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill shifts workload for OIT by extending the reporting deadline. This change does not impact state expenditures or modify existing appropriations, as House Bill 24-1364 created the SLDS Cash Fund and transferred \$5.0 million into the fund in FY 2024-25, to be used by OIT through FY 2026-27.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 24, 2025, and takes effect on August 6, 2025, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
