## A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE CRAIG HOSPITAL LICENSE PLATE DONATION REQUIREMENT.

## **Bill Summary**

Current law requires an applicant to make a donation to Craig hospital in order to be issued a special Craig hospital license plate. The bill repeals the \$20 donation requirement.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

1	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-240, amend
2	(3)(a) as follows:
3	<b>42-3-240.</b> Special plates - Craig hospital. (3) (a) A person may
4	apply for a Craig hospital special license plate if the person pays the taxes
5	and fees required under this section. and provides to the department or an
6	authorized agent a certificate, issued by Craig hospital or its successor
7	organization, confirming that the applicant has donated twenty dollars to
8	Craig hospital.
9	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
10	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
11	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
12	8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a
13	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
14	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
15	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
16	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
17	November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
18	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
