WHEREAS, For more than 60 years The Arc has advocated for	
community supports and services for people with intellectual and	
developmental disabilities; and	
WHEREAS, With 13 local chapters across the state, The Arc of

4	WHEREAS, The Arc believes people with intellectual and
5	developmental disabilities are defined by their strengths, abilities, and

9 10	fundamental moral, civil, and constitutional rights to be fully included and to actively participate in all aspects of society; and
11	WHEREAS, The Arc knows that people with intellectual and
12	developmental disabilities, with appropriate resources and supports, can
13	make decisions about their own lives and must be heard on issues
14	affecting their lives; and
15	WHEREAS, The Arc is committed to working with the Colorado
16	General Assembly, the administration, and state agencies as well as all
17	partners providing advocacy, services, and support for people with
18 19	intellectual and developmental disabilities to increase resources and improve systems so that people can live productive, healthy lives in the
