and linguistically appropriate navigation of services to migrants who have arrived in the United States within the past year and do not qualify for federal support services or refugee resettlement assistance benefits. The bill removes the requirement that a migrant must have arrived in the United States within the past year and instead requires community-based organizations to prioritize assisting migrants who have arrived in the United States within the past 3 years.

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1     *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2             **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-3.7-201, **amend**  
3     (1)(f) as follows:

4             **8-3.7-201. Definitions.** (1) As used in this part 2, unless the  
5     context otherwise requires:

6             (f) "Migrant" means an individual who ~~has arrived in the United~~  
7     ~~States within the past year and~~ does not qualify for federal support  
8     services or refugee resettlement assistance benefits.

9             **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 8-3.7-202, **amend** (2)  
10    introductory portion as follows:

11            **8-3.7-202. Statewide welcome, reception, and integration grant**  
12    **program - created - rules.** (2) Grant recipients shall PRIORITIZE  
13    MIGRANTS WHO HAVE ARRIVED IN THE UNITED STATES WITHIN THE PAST  
14    THREE YEARS AND SHALL use the grant award for one or more of the  
15    following services and programs, including, but not limited to:

16            **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,  
17    determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
18    preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for  
19    the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state  
20    institutions.
