A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE NOXIOUS WEED 102 MANAGEMENT FUND.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. The bill specifies that all state moneys in the noxious weed management fund are subject to annual appropriation and that any unexpended and unencumbered moneys from an appropriation from the fund remain available for expenditure by the department of agriculture in the next fiscal year without further appropriation.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 35-5.5-116, amend 3 (1) as follows: 4 35-5.5-116. Noxious weed management fund - creation -5 **allocation of funds.** (1) There is hereby created in the office of the state 6 treasurer the noxious weed management fund. The fund shall consist 7 CONSISTS of any civil penalties collected pursuant to section 35-5.5-118; 8 any gifts, donations, and grants received pursuant to section 35-1-104(1) 9 (cc); and any moneys approved APPROPRIATED OR TRANSFERRED THERETO 10 by the general assembly. for the purpose of funding noxious weed 11 management projects. All interest derived from the deposit and 12 investment of moneys in the fund shall be credited to the fund. The 13 general assembly shall annually appropriate STATE moneys in the fund to 14 the department of agriculture for the purposes specified in subsection (2) 15 of this section. ANY UNEXPENDED AND UNENCUMBERED MONEYS FROM AN 16 APPROPRIATION FROM THE FUND REMAIN AVAILABLE FOR EXPENDITURE BY 17 THE DEPARTMENT IN THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR WITHOUT FURTHER 18 APPROPRIATION. 19 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 20 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 21 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
