#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriations clause that provides \$1,436,165 General Fund to the Department of Corrections in FY 2025-26. This amount is appropriated to cover 75.0 percent of the cost of inmate phone calls.

Combined with a Long Bill appropriation of \$1,434,634 General Fund, the total appropriation for this purpose in FY 2025-26 is \$2,870,799 General Fund.

## **Points to Consider**

#### **General Fund Impact**

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2025-26 based on the March 2025 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2025-26 budget package \$1,436,165 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill.

# **Future Fiscal Impact**

This bill is projected to require an appropriation of \$2,308,237 General Fund in FY 2026-27 to cover 100.0 percent of the cost of inmate phone calls. Current law requires the Department to cover 100.0 percent of the cost of inmate phone calls in FY 2025-26. This bill pushes that requirement to FY 2026-27. The fiscal note therefore shows that this bill saves \$2,308,237 General Fund in FY 2025-26, but this appropriation will be required in FY 2026-27.
