**BILL TOPIC:** NEUTRAL OVERSIGHT OF OIL AND GAS ACTIVITIES

**Summary of Assessment**

This bill implements a recommendation of the Colorado oil and gas task force to change the word foster to administer in the legislative declaration for the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.

**Background**

The Colorado Oil and Gas Task Force was established by Governor Hickenlooper through Executive Order B 2014-005 on September 8, 2014. The task force convened seven meetings, and issued a final report, which contained nine recommendations for the Governor. The report also contained a minority report which included several recommendations that did not receive the required approval of two-thirds of task force members. Among these recommendations was recommendation #9, which this bill partially implements.

**Assessment**

Because a legislative declaration does not have the force of law, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Effective Date**

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the Senate Agriculture, Natural Resources, and Energy Committee on March 2, 2016.
