A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING EXEMPTIONS FROM DESIGNATED GROUNDWATER**

102 **REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN DRAINS.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. To withdraw groundwater within a designated basin, current law requires a permit issued by the ground water commission, and typically a portion of the groundwater must be replaced. The bill exempts a drain from the permit and replacement obligations if the drain is for residential, commercial, or industrial development or utility lines installed to serve such development; the drain does not penetrate a confining layer; the

removed groundwater is not put to any use other than collecting and removing groundwater from soils; and the removed groundwater is discharged essentially where the drain is located.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 37-90-107, **amend**

3 (1) as follows:

4 **37-90-107. Application for use of groundwater - publication**
5 **of notice - conditional permit - hearing on objections - well permits.**

6 (1) (a) ~~Any~~ EXCEPT AS SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (1)(b) OF THIS SECTION,
7 A person desiring to appropriate groundwater for a beneficial use in a
8 designated groundwater basin ~~shall make application~~ MUST APPLY to the
9 commission in a form ~~to be~~ prescribed by the commission. The applicant
10 ~~shall~~ MUST specify the particular designated groundwater basin or
11 subdivision thereof from which water is proposed to be appropriated, the
12 beneficial use to which it is proposed to apply ~~such~~ THE water, the
13 location of the proposed well, the name of the owner of the land on which
14 ~~such~~ THE well will be located, the estimated average annual amount of
15 water applied for in acre-feet, the estimated maximum pumping rate in
16 gallons per minute, and, if the proposed use is irrigation, the description
17 of the land to be irrigated and the name of the owner thereof, together
18 with such other reasonable information as the commission may designate
19 on the form prescribed. The amount of water applied for shall ~~only~~ be
20 utilized ONLY on the land designated on the application. The place of use
21 shall not be changed without first obtaining authorization from the ground
22 water commission.

23 (b) NEITHER A PERMIT NOR A REPLACEMENT PLAN IS REQUIRED FOR
24 AN UNDERGROUND DRAIN OR SYSTEM OF UNDERGROUND DRAINS THAT

1 COLLECTS AND REMOVES GROUNDWATER FROM SOIL IN CONNECTION WITH
2 RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL, OR INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT OR UTILITY
3 LINES INSTALLED TO SERVE SUCH DEVELOPMENT, IF:

4 (I) THE UNDERGROUND DRAIN OR SYSTEM OF UNDERGROUND
5 DRAINS DOES NOT PENETRATE A CONFINING LAYER;

6 (II) THE REMOVED GROUNDWATER, INSOFAR AS IT IS NOT LEGALLY
7 REUSABLE, IS NOT PUT TO ANY USE OTHER THAN COLLECTING AND
8 REMOVING GROUNDWATER FROM SOILS; AND

9 (III) THE REMOVED GROUNDWATER IS DISCHARGED WITHIN ONE OR
10 MORE DRAINAGE BASINS IN WHICH ALL OR A SUBSTANTIAL PORTION OF THE
11 UNDERGROUND DRAIN OR SYSTEM OF UNDERGROUND DRAINS IS LOCATED,
12 OR IS INFILTRATED INTO THE UNDERLYING GROUNDWATER, ALL WITHIN
13 THE SAME DESIGNATED GROUNDWATER BASIN.

14 **SECTION 2. Applicability.** This act applies to the collection,
15 removal, and discharge of designated groundwater through underground
16 drains occurring on or after the applicable effective date of this act,
17 regardless of whether the underground drains have previously been
18 permitted or are subject to a pending or approved replacement plan.

19 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
20 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
21 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
