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**Bill Topic:** REPEAL OBSOLETE MEDICAID WAIVER PERSONS WITH AIDS

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**Summary of  
Fiscal Impact:** **No Fiscal Impact.** This bill removes statutory references to the People Living with AIDS waiver program. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Appropriation  
Summary:** No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note  
Status:** This fiscal note reflects the enacted bill.

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**Summary of Legislation**

This bill removes statutory references to the now obsolete home- and community-based services (HCBS) waiver program for persons living with AIDS.

**Background**

Colorado currently administers 11 HCBS waiver programs. HCBS waivers provide additional services to specified populations with the purpose of keeping eligible clients in their homes and out of nursing facilities.

**Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

Clients receiving services through the People Living with AIDS HCBS waiver were moved to the Elderly, Blind, and Disabled HCBS waiver as of April 1, 2014. The bill is has no effect on state or local government revenue, expenditures, or workload, and therefore, is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 22, 2018, and took effect on August 8, 2018.
