(1.5) (a) An individual commits retaliation against an elected official if the individual knowingly makes a credible threat as retaliation or retribution against the elected official or arising out of the status of the person as an elected official and is directed against or committed upon:
(	(I) AN ELECTED OFFICIAL; (II) A MEMBER OF THE ELECTED OFFICIAL'S FAMILY; (III) A PERSON IN CLOSE RELATIONSHIP TO THE ELECTED OFFICIAL; OR
]	(IV) A PERSON RESIDING IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD WITH THE ELECTED OFFICIAL.  (b) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBSECTION (1.5):  (I) "CREDIBLE THREAT" MEANS A THREAT, PHYSICAL ACTION, OR REPEATED CONDUCT THAT WOULD CAUSE A REASONABLE PERSON TO BE IN FEAR FOR THE PERSON'S SAFETY OR THE SAFETY OF HIS OR HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY OR OF SOMEONE WITH WHOM THE PERSON HAS OR HAS HAD A CONTINUING RELATIONSHIP. THE THREAT NEED NOT BE DIRECTLY EXPRESSED IF THE TOTALITY OF THE CONDUCT WOULD CAUSE A REASONABLE PERSON SUCH FEAR.
1	(II) "ELECTED OFFICIAL" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO IS SERVING IN AN ELECTED POSITION IN THE STATE OF COLORADO AT ANY LEVEL OF
