ELIMINATE REGISTERED IN NATUROPATHIC DOCTOR TITLE

The bill would have eliminated the word "registered" in the title used by naturopathic doctors. The bill would have created a one-time increase in state workload.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill. This bill was not enacted into law;

therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis do not take effect.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, a naturopathic doctor registered with the Divisions of Professions and Occupations in the Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA) may use the title of "registered naturopathic doctor" or the abbreviation "R.N.D." This bill eliminates the use of the word "registered" from this title and allows the title "naturopathic doctor" or "N.D." to be used.

State Expenditures

The bill results in a one-time increase in workload for DORA to update informational material and rules and to conduct outreach with naturopathic doctors and other stakeholders about the change in title. It is assumed this workload can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

Effective Date

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the Senate Business, Labor, and Technology Committee on February 26, 2018.
