Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides an appropriation of \$44,609 General Fund to the Department of Revenue for FY 2024-25. The provision further appropriates \$2,591 reappropriated funds to the Department of Personnel.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$63.1 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders (a total of \$9.5 million).

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$44,609 for FY 2024-25, reducing the \$63.1 million set aside by the same amount.

TABOR/ Excess State Revenues Impact

The March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast projects a TABOR surplus liability of \$1.3 billion for FY 2024-25 and \$1.8 billion for FY 2025-26 to be refunded to taxpayers out of the General Fund. These sums must be refunded to taxpayers out of the General Fund. This bill is estimated to decrease General Fund revenues by \$800 in FY 2024-25 and by \$17,800 in FY 2025-26, which will result in a decrease in the TABOR surplus liability of equal amounts.
