### **Bill Summary**

Current law provides for the issuance of identification documents, such as driver's licenses, to people who are temporarily present or who are not lawfully present in Colorado. The bill requires the department of

revenue to issue these documents at 10 or more offices geographically distributed throughout the state.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 42-2-508 as 3 follows: 4 **42-2-508.** Fees - operations - rule. (1) The department may 5 promulgate a rule imposing an additional fee for issuance of a document 6 issued under this part 5 to cover the direct and indirect cost of 7 implementing this part 5. The department shall set the fee in accordance 8 with section 42-2-114.5 (2). The department shall transfer the fees to the 9 state treasurer, who shall credit the fees to the licensing services cash 10 fund, created in section 42-2-114.5 (1). 11 By January 31, 2020, the department shall issue 12 IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS UNDER THIS PART 5 IN AN EFFICIENT MANNER 13 AT TEN OR MORE OFFICES, INCLUDING OFFICES OPERATING BEFORE THE 14 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (2), THAT ARE GEOGRAPHICALLY 15 DISTRIBUTED THROUGHOUT THE STATE. 16 **SECTION 2.** Appropriation. For the 2019-20 state fiscal year, 17 \$ is appropriated to the department of revenue, division of motor 18 vehicles. This appropriation is from the licensing services cash fund 19 created in section 42-2-114.5, C.R.S., and is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional FTE. To implement this act, 20 21 the division may use this appropriation for issuing identification 22 documents under part 5 of article 2 of title 42, C.R.S. 23 **SECTION 3.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
