# A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF MARIJUANA EDUCATION
102 MATERIALS.

## **Bill Summary**

# Committee on Cost-benefit Analysis of Legalized Marijuana in Colorado. The bill directs the department of education:

- By July 1, 2017, to create and maintain a resource bank for public schools to use without charge that consists of materials and curricula pertaining to marijuana use; and
- ! Upon request of a public school, to provide technical

assistance in designing age-appropriate curricula on marijuana use.

The bill authorizes resource bank expenses to be paid from the marijuana tax cash fund.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 22-2-127.5 as
3	follows:
4	22-2-127.5. Marijuana education materials - resource bank -
5	technical assistance. (1) The department, with assistance from the
6	DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT, SHALL CREATE AND
7	MAINTAIN A RESOURCE BANK OF MATERIALS AND CURRICULA PERTAINING
8	TO MARIJUANA, WHICH MATERIALS AND CURRICULA MAY BE USED IN
9	ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE STATE.
10	(2) On and after July 1, 2017, the department shall make
11	MATERIAL IN THE RESOURCE BANK AVAILABLE WITHOUT CHARGE TO
12	SCHOOL DISTRICTS, CHARTER SCHOOLS, AND BOARDS OF COOPERATIVE
13	SERVICES. AT THE REQUEST OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, CHARTER SCHOOL, OR
14	BOARD OF COOPERATIVE SERVICES, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE
15	TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, CHARTER SCHOOL, OR
16	BOARD OF COOPERATIVE SERVICES IN DESIGNING AGE-APPROPRIATE
17	CURRICULA PERTAINING TO MARIJUANA USE.
18	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 39-28.8-501, amend
19	$(2)(b)(IV)\ introductory\ portion, (2)(b)(IV)(K), and (2)(b)(IV)(L); and\ \textbf{add}$
20	(2)(b)(IV)(M) as follows:

13	SECTION 22-2-127.5.
14	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
15	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
16	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
