- 10 Page 27, after line 16 insert:
- "SECTION 17. Appropriation. (1) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$800,005 is appropriated to the department of education. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:
  - (a) \$21,700 for use by management and administration for general department and program administration;
  - (b) \$10,900 for use by school district operations for administration related to public school finance; and
  - (c) \$797,405 for use by student pathways for implementation of H.B. 22-1215 task force report, which amount is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 0.2 FTE.
  - (2) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$202,992 is appropriated to the department of education for use by management and administration. This appropriation is from the statewide longitudinal data system cash fund created in section 24-37.5-124 (8)(a), C.R.S., and is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 1.0 FTE.
  - (3) For the 2024-25 state fiscal year, \$4,432,419 is appropriated to the office of the governor for use by the office of information technology. This appropriation is from the statewide longitudinal data system cash fund created in section 24-37.5-124 (8)(a), C.R.S., and is
- based on an assumption that the office will require an additional 6.9 FTE.
