Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$418,118 to the Judicial Department for FY 2023-24, including \$59,318 General Fund and \$358,800 cash funds from the Judicial Department Information Technology Cash Fund. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.8 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) is developing a budget package for FY 2023-24. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$59,318 for FY 2023-24, reducing the General Fund available for other FY 2023-24 appropriations by this amount.
