## **Fiscal Summary of Initiative 11**

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. This fiscal summary identifies the following impact.

**State revenue.** The measure may increase state fine revenue for certain offenses related to impeding the gathering of petition signatures.

**State expenditures.** The measure may increase state workload and costs if a greater number of statewide petitions are administered by the Secretary of State, and if the state Supreme Court reviews more ballot disputes within newly established deadlines.

**Local government impact.** Local governments without a petition process are required to establish one, which increases workload and administrative costs. Local governments may also have an increase in costs if a greater number of petitions are submitted.

**Economic impacts.** While this measure may impact the number and type of citizen-initiative measures proposed or enacted in the future, Initiative 11 itself is not expected to have a direct economic impact on the state.
