**BILL TOPIC:** ANNUAL COMPENSATION REPORT SUBMISSION DEADLINE

**Summary of Legislation**

***Recommended by the Joint Budget Committee***, this bill extends the date by which the annual compensation report and recommendations are required to be submitted by the Department of Personnel and Administration, from August 1 to September 15, 2017, and each September 15 thereafter.

**Assessment**

This bill changes the date by which the annual compensation report and recommendations are due beginning in 2017. The bill does not alter the amount of time and resources needed to prepare the report or recommendations, or the revenue or expenditures for any state or local government agency. As such, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

**Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 25, 2017.
