#### **Amendments in This Packet**

J.004 Staff-prepared appropriation amendment

#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriations clause that provides \$109,664 total funds to the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing for FY 2025-26, including \$54,832 General Fund and \$54,832 matching federal funds.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

#### J.004

Staff amendment **J.004** (attached) makes a technical correction to the appropriations clause to remove the"(I)" note, or informational, designation on the federal funds. The "(I)" note does not apply because there is an "(M)" not designation on the General Fund indicating that the federal funds are a match for the state contribution.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### **General Fund Impact**

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2025-26 based on the March 2025 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$18.2 million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders.

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation for FY 2025-26 of \$54,832, reducing the \$18.2 million set aside by the same amount.

#### **Future Fiscal Impact**

The General Fund cost for the bill doubles in FY 2026-27 and on-going to \$109,663.
