Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

- **J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$3,200,000 to the Department of Revenue for FY 2016-17, including \$2,000,000 from the Highway Users Tax Fund Off-the-top and \$1,200,000 from the Licensing Services Cash Fund. This provision also reduces the General Fund appropriation included in the 2016 Long Bill to the Department of Revenue by \$3,200,000 General Fund.
- **L.001** Bill Sponsor amendment **L.001** (attached) clarifies that the retest fee contemplated by Section 2 of the bill applies to applicants seeking instruction permits in addition to driver's licenses and minor driver's licenses. This amendment does not affect the fiscal impact of the bill.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2016-17 based on the March 2016 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2016-17 budget package the \$3,200,000 General Fund appropriation reduction that would result from the passage of this bill.
