Bill Summary

Sunset Process - State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee. The bill continues the Colorado human trafficking council until September 1, 2024.

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-3-505, **amend** (6)
2 as follows:

3 **18-3-505. Human trafficking council - created - duties - repeal.**
4 (6) This section is repealed, effective ~~September 1, 2019~~ SEPTEMBER 1,
5 2024. Before repeal, the department of regulatory agencies shall review
6 the council pursuant to section 2-3-1203. C.R.S.

7 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**
8 (9)(a)(V); and **add** (15)(a)(VI) as follows:

9 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**
10 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (9) (a) The following statutory
11 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on
12 September 1, 2019:

13 (V) ~~The Colorado human trafficking council created in section~~
14 18-3-505, C.R.S.

15 (15) (a) The following statutory authorizations for the designated
16 advisory committees are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2024:

17 (VI) THE COLORADO HUMAN TRAFFICKING COUNCIL CREATED IN
18 SECTION 18-3-505.

19 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
20 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
21 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
