### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill allows law enforcement agencies to amend written firearm policies to authorize the use of a firearm by an eligible immigrant, in compliance with federal law. Eligible immigrants are defined as persons who maintain valid deferred action status with the Immigration and Naturalization Service. Eligible immigrants are authorized to enroll in peace officer training academies if the eligible immigrant is employed by a law enforcement agency that has a compliant firearm policy. Law enforcement agencies employing eligible immigrants must notify the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) board that an eligible immigrant is compliant with firearm policies while attending a training academy.

### State Expenditures

The bill may increase workload in the POST board to promulgate rules incorporating the provisions of the bill. Any rule promulgation will occur during normal rulemaking efforts over the course of a fiscal year. As such, no change in appropriations is required.

### **Local Government**

To the extent that local law enforcement agencies update their policies, workload for local law enforcement agencies will increase.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
