Overview. The bill requires schools to acquire and place AEDs at athletic events.

Summary of Legislation

The bill requires public schools, school districts, and nonpublic schools that have or acquire an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) to place and maintain the AED in accordance with nationally recognized, evidence-based standards for emergency cardiovascular care.

School District

Beginning in FY 2026-27, local education providers will adjust their use of AEDS to comply with national standards. This workload is assumed to be minimal.

Effective Date

The bill takes was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 5, 2025.
