**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating \$4,981,720 General Fund to the Department of Education for FY 2021-22. This provision also states

that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.1 FTE.

## **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package \$5,000,000 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill. Specifically, the JBC package includes a place holder of \$800.0 million General Fund for those bills that are part of the "State Stimulus Package", and this bill is part of that package.
