Bill Sponsor amendment - changes FY 2027-28 appropriation

#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill neither requires nor contains an appropriation clause.

## **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

#### L.009

Bill sponsor amendment **L.009** (attached) increases General Fund expenditures by \$63,154 in FY 2027-28 for the Department of Public Health and Environment. This is the same amount shown in the first revised fiscal note dated 03/27/25. It does not change the FY 2027-28 fiscal impact for the Department of Revenue. LCS and JBC staff agree on the fiscal impact of this amendment.

The amendment repeals the Finance Committee report and reinstates the requirement for kei vehicles to undergo emissions inspections. Additionally, it simplifies the definition of a kei vehicle by removing the requirement to determine the purpose for which the vehicle was imported. Instead, the new criteria

state that a vehicle qualifies as a kei vehicle if it is 25 years old at the time of import or if it is 25 years old and has been previously titled.
