101     **CONCERNING CONTINUING THE MICROGRIDS FOR COMMUNITY**  
102     **RESILIENCE GRANT PROGRAM.**

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**Bill Summary**

The microgrids for community resilience grant program (grant program) in the division of local government in the department of local affairs provides grants for cooperative electric associations and municipally owned utilities to purchase microgrid resources for eligible rural communities located within their service territories. Under current law, the grant program is set to repeal on September 1, 2026. The bill

continues the grant program indefinitely by removing the repeal date.

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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 40-9.8-104, **amend**  
3 (5) introductory portion; and **repeal** (7) as follows:

4 **40-9.8-104. Microgrids for community resilience grant**  
5 **program - creation - grant application process - report.**

6 (5) ~~On or before December 1, 2023, and~~ NOTWITHSTANDING  
7 SECTION 24-1-136 (11)(a)(I), on or before December 1 of each year,  
8 ~~thereafter,~~ the division shall submit a report summarizing the grants  
9 awarded in the previous twelve months through the grant program,  
10 including:

11 (7) ~~This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2026.~~

12 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,  
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
14 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for  
15 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state  
16 institutions.
