BILL TOPIC: UPDATE OUTDATED STATUTES PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Summary of Legislation

This bill updates terms in statute that refer to people with intellectual and developmental disabilities using outdated terminology. Under current law, the terms mentally retarded, mentally deficient person, mental deficiency, and mentally deficient are used; this bill replaces those terms with intellectual and developmental disability. Additionally, it replaces mental defect with mental illness, and physical defect with physical disability.

Assessment

Correcting these statutory citations will have no impact on the expenditures or revenues of any state agency or local government, and, therefore, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. This fiscal note assumes that agencies already use these modern terms, and no updates in rules or documents are required. It is assumed that any required changes will be accomplished during the course of regular agency operations.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
