1 WHEREAS, Spinal muscular atrophy (SMA) is the leading genetic
2 killer of children under the age of two, and one in 50 Americans carries
3 the gene that causes SMA; and

4 WHEREAS, SMA is known to cause degeneration in voluntary
5 muscle movement for those who survive the disease; and

6 WHEREAS, SMA crosses all racial and ethnic boundaries,
7 affecting people of all ages and genders; and

8 WHEREAS, Increased awareness about SMA will lead to
