A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING MENTAL HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS WHO ARE
102 PERMITTED TO PERFORM AURICULAR ACUDETOX.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Current law allows licensed mental health care professionals and level III certified addiction counselors who have documented that they have undergone auricular acudetox training to perform auricular acudetox. The bill allows registered psychotherapists who have documented that they have undergone the same training requirements to also perform auricular acudetox.
