Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-third General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:

(1) That, pursuant to the provisions of section 2-2-305, Colorado Revised Statutes, the following positions are hereby created for the Second Regular Session of the Seventy-third General Assembly with the monthly compensation to be paid to the persons elected or appointed to each position in the range set opposite the position:

*The Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives are authorized to hire Legislative Aides pursuant to Joint Rule 39 of the House of Representatives and the Senate. If Legislative Aides are authorized by the Executive Committee, acting in accordance with such Joint Rule 39, to start prior to the convening of the next regular session, they may be paid at the rate specified in this resolution from the date they are authorized to start.

(2) That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives remain in such capacity after adjournment of the General Assembly *sine die* until the convening of the First Regular

Session of the Seventy-fourth General Assembly in January, 2023.

- (3) That the President of the Senate and the Chair of the House Services Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, are hereby separately authorized to retain and hire replacements for such employees for such period of time in the interim between the Second Regular Session of the Seventy-third General Assembly and the First Regular Session of the Seventy-fourth General Assembly as they deem necessary for their respective houses; except that the office equipment of the General Assembly and the services of such employees shall be used only in connection with official legislative business.
- (4) That the President of the Senate and the Chair of the House Services Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, are hereby separately authorized to hire such session-only employees for the next regular session as they deem necessary for their respective houses and who may start their employment on the date authorized.
