**Bill Topic: EQUITY IN ACCESS TO CLINICAL TRIALS IN MEDICAID** 

Summary of No fiscal impact. This bill codifies the current Medicaid practice of reimbursing **Fiscal Impact:** 

providers for medically necessary services in clinical trials. It is assessed as having

no fiscal impact.

**Appropriation** Summary:

No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note** Status:

The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

## **Summary of Legislation**

The bill requires Medicaid to pay for routine costs associated with participation in an approved clinical trial for a Medicaid client. Routine costs are defined to mean medically necessary services included under Medicaid regardless of participation in a clinical trial.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

The bill codifies current policy to cover medically necessary services during a clinical trial. The bill does not affect state or local government revenue or expenditures, and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect August 5, 2020, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 6, 2020, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
