#### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill requires the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) to make grants in support of the USS Colorado, a nuclear submarine expected to be commissioned in 2017. The grants will be used for the following purposes:

- to pay for expenses related to the commissioning of the USS Colorado;
- to promote awareness of the USS Colorado within the state; and
- to support the crew of the USS Colorado.

For FY 2017-18, the bill contains a General Fund appropriation of \$100,000 to the DMVA.

#### **State Expenditures**

This bill requires the DMVA to make grants to support the USS Colorado, and the bill includes an appropriation of \$100,000 for this purpose. The administration of this grant program will be consistent with other grants run by the department, and it is assumed the department will use 1 percent, or \$1,000, for administrative expenses and \$99,000 for grants.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 5, 2017, and became effective on July 1, 2017.

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#### **State Appropriations**

Consistent with the fiscal note, for FY 2017-18, the bill includes an appropriation of \$100,000 from the General Fund to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs.
