#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$587,347 cash funds from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund, which is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 3.0 FTE. Of this amount \$4,630 is reappropriated to the Department of Personnel for leased vehicles.

#### **Points to Consider**

## Marijuana Tax Cash Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2022-23 based on the March 2022 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$4.7 million available for appropriation or transfer from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2022-23, based on that revenue forecast. This bill requires an appropriation/transfer of \$587,347 from the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund for FY 2022-23, reducing the anticipated balance by the same amount.
