Summary Information

Overview. The bill creates a definition of "eligible person" within the Direct Care Workforce Stabilization Board statute.

Summary of Legislation

In 2023, Senate Bill 23-261 referenced a definition of "eligible person" and Senate Bill 23-289 subsequently modified the definition. The bill makes a technical change to remove the reference to the modified definition in the Consumer-Directed Care section of the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing's statutes, and codify the definition into the Direct Care Workforce Stabilization Board section of the Department of Labor and Employment's statutes.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The technical changes in the bill codify current practice, and will not change the revenue or expenditures of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
