WHICH AMOUNT THE COMMISSION SHALL, BY RULE, 20 ANNUALLY ADJUST BASED ON THE ANNUAL PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN THE 21 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF LABOR'S BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS 22 CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, OR A SUCCESSOR INDEX, FOR 23 DENVER-AURORA-LAKEWOOD FOR ALL ITEMS PAID FOR BY URBAN
- 25 (B) FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, UP TO FIVE THOUSAND 26 EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR EVERY THIRTY DAYS THAT THE OWNER IS 27 IN VIOLATION, WHICH AMOUNT THE COMMISSION MAY, BY RULE, 28 ANNUALLY ADJUST IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (1)(i)(I)(A) OF THIS 29 SECTION.".".
