The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates a total of \$3,800 cash funds from the Inspection and Consumer Services Cash Fund to the Department of Agriculture for FY 2016-17. This provision also appropriates \$3,800 to the Department of Law from reappropriated funds for the provision of legal services to the Department of Agriculture.
