Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Education Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies, as specified in the department's sunset review of the school

safety resource center advisory board, to continue the advisory board indefinitely.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 3 (13)(a)(IV) as follows: 4 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 5 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (13) (a) The following statutory 6 authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for 7 repeal on September 1, 2022: 8 (IV) The school safety resource center advisory board created in 9 section 24-33.5-1804; 10 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1804, repeal 11 (6) as follows: 12 24-33.5-1804. School safety resource center advisory board -13 created. (6) (a) This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2022. 14 (b) Prior to said repeal, the advisory board appointed pursuant to 15 this section shall be reviewed as provided in section 2-3-1203, C.R.S. 16 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 17 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 18 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 19 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 20 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 21 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 22 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 23 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 24 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
