After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
HB23-1221 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and substitute:
"SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-8-103, add (19.5) as follows:
25-8-103. Definitions. As used in this article 8, unless the context
otherwise requires:
(19.5) "TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD" MEANS THE CALCULATION
OF THE DAILY MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF A POLLUTANT FROM ALL SOURCES
THAT IS ALLOWED TO ENTER STATE WATERS SO THAT AN APPLICABLE
WATER QUALITY STANDARD IS MET.
SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-8-202, amend
(1)(p) and $(1)(q)$; and add $(1)(r)$ as follows:
25-8-202. Duties of commission - rules. (1) The commission
shall develop and maintain a comprehensive and effective program for
prevention, control, and abatement of water pollution and for water
quality protection throughout the entire state and, to ensure provision of
continuously safe drinking water by public water systems, and, in
connection therewith, shall:
(p) Establish, and revise as necessary, a schedule of nonrefundable
fees to cover the reasonable costs of implementing a program for the
beneficial use of biosolids, in accordance with section 30-20-110.5; C.R.S.; and
(q) Hear appeals of penalties imposed pursuant to section

(r) On or before January 1, 2025, after soliciting input from interested parties, issue written guidance specific to total

and regulations for drinking water; AND

25-1-114.1 (2.5) for a violation of minimum general sanitary standards

MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD DEVELOPMENT THAT ADDRESSES WATER QUALITY DATA COLLECTION BEST PRACTICES, RELIABLE ANALYTICAL METHODS, DATA QUALITY ASSURANCE, AND THE APPROPRIATE LEVEL OF GEOGRAPHIC AND HYDROLOGICAL ACCURACY.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-8-501, **add** (7) as follows:

- **25-8-501.** Permits required for discharge of pollutants administration. (7) On and after January 1, 2026, the division shall determine a total maximum daily load for state waters as directed by the commission using credible data, which includes:
- (a) Data that has been collected in the last five years; and
- (b) HISTORICAL DATA THAT IS RELEVANT FOR ESTABLISHING A TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD.

SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."
