11 12 13 14	WHEREAS, The many out-of-state visitors who come to Colorado to attend rodeos contribute a great deal to the state's economy, and, in addition, countless local and national charitable organizations benefit from the revenue generated by the sport of rodeo; and
15 16	WHEREAS, The net positive effect of rodeo on the state's economy is an estimated \$150 million; and
17 18 19	WHEREAS, Professional rodeo is the highlight of events such as the annual Colorado State Fair, which generates approximately \$33 million in economic activity statewide and supports 374 jobs; and
20 21 22 23 24 25	WHEREAS, Professional rodeo is a centerpiece of the National Western Stock Show and Rodeo, which includes 19 professional rodeo performances, attracts nearly 650,000 visitors, provides for over 40 full-time jobs and 800 seasonal positions, generates an economic impact of \$115 million, utilizes over 650 volunteers from the local area, and raises over \$613,000 through the Junior Livestock Auction annually; and
26 27 28 29 30	WHEREAS, The PRCA demonstrates its commitment to the next generation of cowboys and cowgirls by sponsoring college scholarships for youths and supporting youth rodeo divisions in various rodeo organizations, which attract participation from hundreds of Colorado young people; now, therefore,
