Summary of Legislation

In 2015, the Colorado Supreme Court held in *St. Jude's Co. v. Roaring Fork Club, LLC*, that the diversion of water from a surface stream into a private ditch on private property for aesthetic, recreational, and piscatorial purposes is not a beneficial use of water under Colorado water law. This bill limits the application of this decision to direct flow appropriations without storage made after July 15, 2015.

State Expenditures

This bill provides direction to water courts in deciding pending cases that could be subject to the *St. Jude's Co. v. Roaring Fork Club, LLC* decision. To the extent that this facilitates those decisions, this bill will minimally reduce the workload of the water courts. This reduction does not require a change in appropriations.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
