HOUSE BILL 16-1152

CONCERNING THE AUTHORITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO  
DISTRIBUTE MEDICATION.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

**SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-42.5-118, **amend** (15) (b) as follows:

**12-42.5-118. Compounding - dispensing - sale of drugs and devices - rules.** (15) (b) The following may distribute compounded and prepackaged medications, without limitation, to pharmacies under common ownership of the entity:

(I) A prescription drug outlet owned and operated by a hospital that is accredited by the joint commission on accreditation of healthcare organizations or a successor organization; **and**

(II) A prescription drug outlet operated by a health maintenance organization, as defined in section 10-16-102, C.R.S.; AND

(III) THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS.

**SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
