A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING REQUIRING PET CARE FACILITIES TO PROVIDE 102 NOTIFICATION OF AN INFECTIOUS DISEASE OUTBREAK.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill requires any pet care facility (facility) licensed under the "Pet Animal Care and Facilities Act" to notify pet animal owners within 24 hours after a suspected outbreak of an infectious disease is discovered at the facility.

| 9 | REASONABLE ATTEMPT TO NOTIFY ALL PET ANIMAL OWNERS WHO ARE |
| 10 | CURRENT PATRONS OF THE PET CARE FACILITY OF THE SUSPECTED |

| 12 | (a) Posting notice in a conspicuous location on the pet |
| 13 | CARE FACILITY PREMISES; |
| 14 | (b) POSTING NOTICE ON THE PET CARE FACILITY'S WEBSITE, IF ONE |

| 16 | (c) DIRECTLY CONTACTING A PET ANIMAL OWNER THROUGH ANY |
