### A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING EXTENDING THE REPEAL DATE FOR THE EARLY CHILDHOOD LEADERSHIP COMMISSION.

### **Bill Summary**

Under current law, the early childhood leadership commission is scheduled to repeal on September 1, 2018. The bill extends the repeal date to September 1, 2020.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

6	FOR REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH section 2-3-1203 (3), C.R.S.
7	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal (3)
8	(ee) (V); and <b>add</b> (3) (gg.5) (II) as follows:
9	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees. (3) The

11	designated advisory committee is scheduled for repeal:

22	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
23	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
24	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
25	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
26	November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
27	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
