Only a licensed medical marijuana store or retail marijuana store may hold prepaid customer funds. This provision does not prohibit a third-party financial institution, credit card company, or other payment processor from facilitating a payment by a customer to a medical marijuana store or a retail marijuana store for products previously ordered from the medical marijuana store or retail marijuana store by the customer.".

- **SECTION 4.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-203, **add** (2)(dd)(XIII.5) as follows:
- **44-10-203.** State licensing authority rules. (2) Mandatory rule-making. Rules promulgated pursuant to section 44-10-202 (1)(c) must include but need not be limited to the following subjects:
- (dd) Requirements for medical marijuana and medical marijuana products delivery as described in section 44-10-501 (11) and section 44-10-505 (5) and retail marijuana and retail marijuana products delivery as described in section 44-10-601 (13) and section 44-10-605 (5), including:
- (XIII.5) EMERGENCY EXEMPTIONS TO HOURS OF OPERATIONS AS IT PERTAINS TO A RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE DELIVERY PERMIT HOLDER. THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL ENSURE THE RULES ARE EFFECTIVE BY JANUARY 1, 2022.
- **SECTION 5.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-601, **amend** (13)(f)(VII) as follows:
- **44-10-601. Retail marijuana store license rules definitions.** (13) (f) In accordance with this subsection (13) and rules adopted to implement this subsection (13), a licensed retail marijuana store with a valid retail marijuana delivery permit may:
- (VII) (A) Use an employee to conduct deliveries or contract with a retail marijuana transporter that has a valid retail marijuana delivery permit to conduct deliveries on its behalf, from its retail marijuana store or its associated state licensing authority-authorized storage facility as defined by rule.
- 38 (B) If a licensed retail marijuana store contracts with a 39 retail marijuana transporter to conduct the deliveries for the 40 store and the state licensing authority finds the transporter



- VIOLATED THIS ARTICLE 10, OR ANY RULE PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO
  THIS ARTICLE 10, WHEN THE VIOLATION IS RELATED TO DELIVERY AND THE
  STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY DEEMS IT TO BE A VIOLATION OF PUBLIC
  SAFETY, THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL NOTIFY THE STORE OF
  THE VIOLATION. A VIOLATION AFFECTING PUBLIC SAFETY INCLUDES THE
  TRANSFER OF REGULATED MARIJUANA TO A PERSON UNDER TWENTY-ONE
  YEARS OF AGE, THE TRANSFER OF REGULATED MARIJUANA IN EXCESS OF
  SALES LIMITATIONS, AND THE DIVERSION OF REGULATED MARIJUANA.
  - (C) IF THE STORE CONTINUES TO CONTRACT WITH THE RETAIL MARIJUANA TRANSPORTER TO CONDUCT THE STORE'S DELIVERIES AND THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY FINDS THE TRANSPORTER COMMITTED A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION OF THIS ARTICLE 10, OR ANY RULE PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE 10, WHEN THE VIOLATION IS RELATED TO DELIVERY, IS DEEMED A VIOLATION AFFECTING PUBLIC SAFETY, AND OCCURS WITHIN A YEAR OF THE FINAL AGENCY ACTION VIOLATION OF A PREVIOUS VIOLATION, THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY SHALL INITIATE ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION AGAINST THE RETAIL MARIJUANA STORE IN ADDITION TO ANY DISCIPLINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION AGAINST THE RETAIL MARIJUANA TRANSPORTER.
  - (D) NOTHING IN THIS SUBSECTION (13)(f)(VII) LIMITS THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE DISCIPLINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION AGAINST A RETAIL MARIJUANA TRANSPORTER OR MEDICAL MARIJUANA TRANSPORTER FOR VIOLATIONS OF STATE LAW OR RULE.

**SECTION 6.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-803, **add** (4) as follows:

**44-10-803. Fees.** (4) The state licensing authority shall waive the initial application and license fees for transporter licenses and delivery permits if the person applying for the transporter license or delivery permit meets the criteria established pursuant to section 44-10-308 (4).

**SECTION 7.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 44-10-1401, **amend** (2) as follows:

**44-10-1401. Sunset review - repeal of article.** (2) Prior to the repeal of this article 10, the department of regulatory agencies shall conduct a sunset review as described in section 24-34-104 (5), AND, IN THAT REVIEW, THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES MUST REVIEW THE METRICS AND IMPACTS OF THE REGULATIONS ON RETAIL SALES.".
