HOUSE BILL 16-1419

AN ACT

Concerning a reduction in the amount of the general fund reserve required for the fiscal year 2015-16.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-75-201.1, **amend** (1) (d) (XIV); and **add** (1) (d) (XVII) as follows:

- **24-75-201.1.** Restriction on state appropriations legislative declaration definitions. (1) (d) For each fiscal year, unrestricted general fund year-end balances shall be retained as a reserve in the following amounts:
- (XIV) For the fiscal year 2014-15 and each fiscal year thereafter, EXCLUDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2015-16, six and one-half percent of the amount appropriated for expenditure from the general fund for that fiscal year.
- (XVII) For the fiscal year 2015-16, five and six-tenths percent of the amount appropriated for expenditure from the general fund for that fiscal year.
- **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
